PROBLEMS OF THE PRESENT TIME

INTERMISSION: THE FRENCH VALTORTA DAY

The day consisted of Mass, prayers and various speakers. We returned home happily and safely on 21 May. Thanks to God.

We were in Paris to attend the «Second day of National friends of Maria Valtorta», and after travelling over 1,000 km. by car from Italy, by the Grace of God, we arrived in the evening of 19 May. The following day, we participated to various prayers, and speakers guests attended the conference. We thanked God for letting us get back home happyily, safely without any obstacles.

For me and Gabriele Cajano, it was our first time, but it was Francesco Penati's second time. He was there last year, therefore he knew the best way to move around Paris. All three of us congratulated Bruno Perrinet and Jerome Bayle for this wonderful initiative taking place in the French Nation. The purpose of this "get together" day was to involve as many people as possible employing the Parish of Notre-Dame d'Auteuil in Paris as a venue, through the Foundation economic founds. This conference, the testimony and the reading took place entirely in this church, and at least 400 people attended from all over France. Unfortunately Eng. Jean-François Lavère and Monsignor René Laurentin were unable to attend due to physical indisposition, but that did not detract from the day.



The following day, on 20 May in the morning, Holy Mass was celebrated in the crypt along with the Holy Rosary led by Bruno Perrinet.



We were then invited to go down the side street to a building on the grounds, which I presume belongs to the parish, where there were books edited by «Ressemblement a son Image Edition» on sale that I still presume are owned by Bruno Perrinet.







In the afternoon from 2:00 pm, the various speakers forwarded one another their works. It started with Père Yannik Bonnet's Conference on the Valtorta Major Work,



then Mrs Vèronique Lèvy with a wonderful dramatic reading of a Valtorta passage where Jesus comments on his Passion (vol 10, Chapter 613).



Thenceforth a former professional footballer, Florian Boucansaud, gave a testimony on his profound conversion to Jesus through reading the Works of Maria Valtorta.

There was a brief address made by the Italian CEV followed by Bruno Perrinet, the president of the Maria Valtorta Association, that concluded the conference.



The solemnity of the place and the Pastoral duties (Holy Mass at 6:30 pm) did not allow any opportunity for a dialogue to take place between those who attended and the guest speakers, and this somehow detracted from the day, but I do not think it could have been done any differently.

However, I must admit that I did not realise that the room where the conference took place was actually the central nave of the church of Notre-Dame d'Auteuil. I thought it was another part of this church or the parish hall. To my utter astonishment, in allowing the nave to be used, the parish priest of this church literally gave his consent to people to talk about Maria Valtorta. We all constantly know the reluctance of priests to allow people to speak about Maria Valtorta in parishes in Italy.

And the 'allergic reaction' of priests towards Maria Valtorta is also very strong here. In France I thought this was impossible.

If it had been a church run by traditionalists, it could have been possible because in that environment, Maria Valtorta would have been accepted, but that this could happen in a 'normal' parish dumbfounded me. I praise and applaud this parish priest: Fr. Antoine de Romanet for his outrageous courage.
